



Rector's instructions No. 5/2020 (V. 21.)

on the modification of certain measures related to the closure of
academic year 2019/2020, semester 2 at Óbuda University

Pursuant to Government Decree 168/2020 (IV. 30.) on protective measures, and Government Decree 211/2020 (V. 16.) on protective measures in the capital city, student hostels of higher education institutions are still prohibited to be visited by students in the entire country. In order to ensure equal opportunities for students and to protect the health of both professors and students, the following shall be ordered in connection with the closure of academic year 2019/2020, semester 2, and with the preparation of academic year 2020/2021, semester 1:

1. No contact classes, group consultations and contact examinations may be organized at Óbuda University until 04 July 2020.
2. Section 5 of Rector's instructions No. 3/2020 (IV. 21.) shall cease to have effect: even in the case of the subjects specified therein, intra-semester requirements may be performed and testing may be conducted only online. These courses are required to be closed subject to the end-of-year requirements set out in the sample curriculum.
3. In the event that only partial performance may be completed online as compared to the subject requirements specified in the official announcement regarding any courses set out in section 2, the syllabus and requirements of the course shall be modified. In the event that such a subject is a pre-requisite for registering to a subject to be announced in semester 1 of academic year 2020/2021, cancelled contact lessons may be recovered by 30 September 2020. This also requires modification of the syllabus of the subject to be announced in the fall semester and the timetable needs to be adjusted accordingly.
4. The changes specified in sections 2 and 3 shall be authorized by the Dean of the Faculty.
5. The changes specified in sections 2 and 3 are required to be notified to the students affected in a Neptun message by 29 May 2020, with particular regard to the obligation to make up for cancelled contact lessons, the manner and scheduled dates thereof.
6. Arrangements for the completion of cancelled contact lessons may be made for the registration week as well. In respect of arrangements for the completion of cancelled contact lessons made for the registration week, the summer internship practice of students in a dual mode of study is required to be taken into consideration.

These instructions shall enter into effect on 21 May 2020 and shall be valid until 30 September 2020.
