The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

**SI LJUBLJA01:** At Ljubljana University (SI LJUBLJANA01) the grading system varies between 1 (lower) and 10 (highest) with the lowest pass mark being 6. All courses are organized in ECTS credits. A final transcript with the local and ECTS grade is provided to the student.
