2. The receiving institution will send its decision within **4** weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **5** weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [*It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines*]
4. Termination of the agreement

*[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]*

## **F. Information**

### **1. Grading systems of the institutions**

**FACHHOCHSCHULE DORTMUND** : The results obtained by the student in each of the subjects will be graded according to the following numerical scale. This grading scheme in Germany usually comprises five levels with numerical equivalents. The minimum passing grade is "ausreichend" (sufficient).

1,0 – 1,5 (sehr gut = very good)

1,6 – 2,5 (gut = good)

2,6 – 3,5 (befriedigend = satisfactory)

3,6 – 4,0 (ausreichend = sufficient)

4,5 - up (nicht bestanden = fail)

One Semester: 30 ECTS credits

one full academic year: 60 ECTS credits
